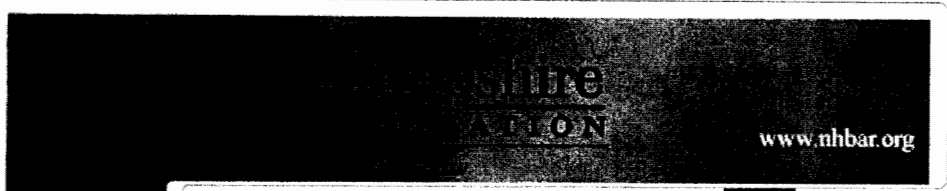

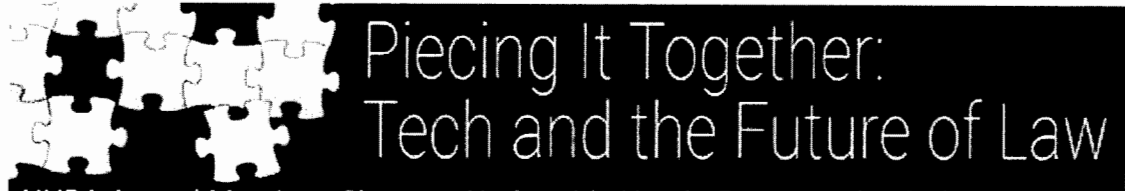

James J. Sandman has been president of the Legal Services Corporation, the country's largest funder of civil legal aid programs, since 2011. He practiced law with Arnold & Porter for 30 years and served as the firm's managing partner for a decade. From 2007 to 2011, he was general counsel for the District of Columbia Public Schools. Sandman is a past president of the DC Bar and chair of the DC Circuit Judicial Conference's Stand Committee on Pro Bono Legal Services. He is a member of the DC Access to Justice Commission of the Pro Bono Institute's Law Firm Pro Bono Project Advisory Committee. He is the recipient of many awards and honors for his leadership and service.

Paul Lippe is the former CEO of OnRamp Systems Inc., a leader in the development of legal department productivity platforms, which was recently sold to Elevate Services, a global legal service provider to corporate legal departments and law firms. First developed for Cisco Systems, Legal OnRamp is a free web-based platform for in-house counsel, designed to help legal departments reduce costs and improve quality through collaboration. In addition, Lippe writes for the American Bar Association Legal Rebels blog "the New Normal," which discusses how the practice of law is being remade. Rebecca Love Kourlis is a former Colorado trial court judge and former justice of the Colorado Supreme Court. Currently, she serves as executive director of the Institute for the Advancement of American Legal System (IAALS). After nearly two decades of service to Colorado's judiciary, Kourlis resigned in 2006 to establish the IAALS, a national, independent research center housed at the University of Denver. She is the recipient of the 2012 John Marshall Award, presented by the ABA Justice Center for her dedication to the improvement of the administration of justice; the US Chamt of Commerce Legal Reform Organization of the Year Award (2007); and the ABA Judicial Division Robert B. Yegge Award for Outstanding Contribution in the Field of Judicial Administration (2009).
