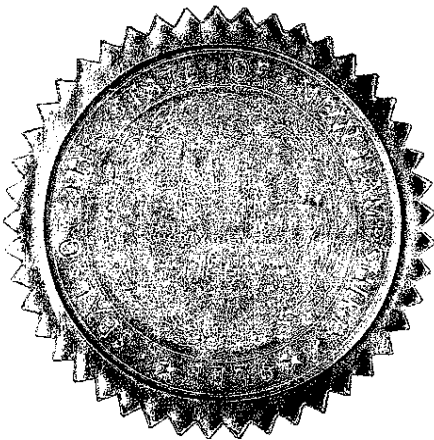
An Order Establishing Policy for Mosquito Control on State Lands

WHEREAS, mosquitoes and mosquito-borne illnesses pose a threat to the public health in New Hampshire;

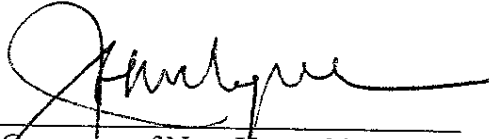
WHEREAS, when an increased threat of disease is discovered through surveillance, targeted control of mosquitoes may be an appropriate measure to reduce human health risk;

WHEREAS, the promulgation of a mosquito control policy for state-owned lands will ensure a clear, consistent and coordinated effort by state government in New Hampshire;

NOW THEREFORE, I, JOHN H. LYNCH, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE, by the authority vested in me by part II, article 41, of the New Hampshire Constitution do hereby promulgate a Policy for Mosquito Control on State Lands. This policy shall govern all departments in the executive branch of the State of New Hampshire.
