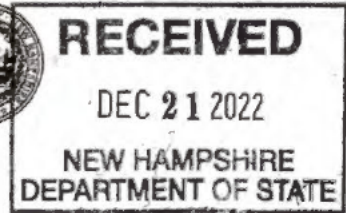

NCLGS—a group of legislators who are neither pro nor anti gaming—works to ensure proper regulation of legalized gaming in the states that chose to permit gaming.
