A lobbyist registration form reports the existence of a relationship between a single client and either a single lobbyist or a partnership, firm, or corporation with one or more partners, members, or employees who will be acting as lobbyists for that client. A lobbyist is a person employed in a representative capacity to promote or oppose, directly or indirectly, any legislation pending or proposed before the general court, or to promote or oppose, directly or indirectly, any action by the governor, governor and council, or any state agency, where such action concerns legislation or contracts pending or proposed before the general court, any pending administrative rule, or the procurement of goods or services that are being or may be purchased by the state. RSA 15:1: See also RSA 15:1. Ill (for a description of persons who fall within this definition but who are not required to register).
