EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 93 - 3

An order transferring the Town of Wakefield from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 2 to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 7 **and** transferring the Town of Wilmot from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 3 to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 5A.

- WHEREAS, RSA 36:45 provides that the boundaries of delineated planning regions in the State may be adjusted to accommodated changing conditions; and
- WHEREAS, the Selectmen of the Town of Wakefield filed an official request, dated May 25, 1993, with the Director of the Office of State Planning to transfer the Town from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 2, to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 7; and
- WHEREAS, the Selectmen of the Town of Wilmot filed an official request, dated May 26, 1993 with the Director of the Office of State Planning to transfer the Town from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 3 to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 5A; and
- WHEREAS, the Lakes Region Planning Commission (Region 2) and the Strafford Regional Planning Commission (Region 7) concur in the transfer of the Town of Wakefield, and the Upper Valley-Lake Sunapee Regional Planning Commission (Region 3) and the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission concur in the transfer of the Town of Wilmot; and
- WHEREAS, the Director of the Office of State Planning approves these transfers;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, STEPHEN MERRILL, GOVERNOR of the State of New Hampshire, by virtue of the authority vested in me under Part 2, Article 41 Of the New Hampshire Constitution, do hereby order that:

the Town Of Wakefield be and hereby is transferred from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 2 to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 7, effective October 1, 1993;

the Town of Wilmot be and hereby is transferred from New Hampshire Planning Region No. 3 to New Hampshire Planning Region No. 5A effective October 1, 1993.
