EXHIBIT T to Emergency Order #29

N.H. Department of Safety, October 15, 2020

Pursuant to Emergency Order #29, which authorizes temporary modification of executive branch deadlines and other requirements, issued pursuant to Section 18 of Executive Order 2020-04 as modified and extended by Emergency Orders 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, 2020-15, 2020-16, 2020-17, and 2020-18, the following is hereby ordered:

Staffing of EMS Providers

For the duration of the State of Emergency, EMS providers may transport a patient in an EMS land or water vehicle with only one provider at the level EMT, AEMT, or paramedic, attending to the patient.

Expiration of Currently Licensed EMS Providers

Notwithstanding any administrative rule to the contrary, the expiration of a provider's license at any level, other than apprentice providers and licensed NH EMT-B providers not certified by the National Registry, shall expire 30 calendar days after the expiration date of the National Registry level documentation, provided that the National Register has extended the expiration date of a provider's certification.
