Please be advised that your SEARCH (as recommended by me in paragraph A on page 3 of this Appeal) for Gary B. Richardson's "subscri"ption to his RSA Ch. 92:2 oath of office can end with the photocopy of it on the document MADE by the Office of the Scretary of State to which it is marked at the bottom thereof "To be returned" to there at the State House, and so, as indicated in my letter of Sept. 16th 02 to Bill Gardner, the Secretary of State WARNing that any oaths "shall" be also MADE by the oath-TAKER and NOT the oath GIVEr; see R.S.A. Chapter 92:2 (page 30 of the 2001 statute book for Title 6 of PUBLIC OFFICERS, then any schedule, hearing and decision by those NOT in compliance 5204.20 be UNlawful. See also the NOTICE of RSA 665:6-a HEARING and of "no issues to be heard at this time" (emphasis added for NOT the time, no \_\_:\_ o'clock a.m. or p.m. given, BUT the DAY) and luckily for me, my having checked in that morning f(9/2)just before 9:00 a.m. the posting at the Receptionist's desk at the L.O.B. for the Room 303 hearing that by-passed the due-process of my having been notified Modalled ahead of time like Fergus Cullen was for his hearing so that Dick Marple could attend AGAIN to re-emphasize what is a major undertaking of akin to brain surgery: to try to get it through their thick skulls that notes and checks are NOT the PAYments required "at the time" of filing, (empshasis added AGAIN for this day/time differential!). now compare it to the 2-page ORDER ON MOTION TO DISQUALIFY (with two attachments of two pages each = 4 extra pages + 2 = 6 in total), the Chairman FINALly got around to answering my complaint in this department, but only partial to NOT the July 12th (Friday) hearing AND decision BUT my emphasis on the details in this 92:2 that requires them to "make" and subscribe, it clearing having been NOT made by either Gregg or Rice who BOTH used the incorrect forms supplied by the Secretary of State's Office. Furthermore having supplemented the MOTION TO DISQUALIFY for the reason that Hugh Gregg benefits financially as an officer/stockholder of the then and now Indian Head and Fleet Banks respectfully that MUST disqualify him as prejudiced FOR circulating NOTES of the Federal Reserve to where his bank is a member that are LOANed into use rather than SPENT as coins that even MAKE the government money by the seigniorage: "a government revenue derived from the manufacture of coins that is circulated in the U.S. as the difference or between the monetary and bullion value...."

See also RSA Ch. 665:1,II for the placement of "The alternate member appointed by the supreme court shall be an attorney...(and) shall perform the duties of the chairman and shall always be the alternate to temporarily fill the chairman's place." (emphasis ADDed), and who MAY(?) take the place of one of the other two commissioners? Alt.
