## REQUESTED ACTION

### **EXPLANATION**

Approval of this request to extend sub grants awarded under the Federal Fiscal Year 2012 Victims Of Crime Act (VOCA) award from the Office for Victims of Crime will allow the above providers to expend the remaining funds and to continue existing programs providing direct services to victims of crime, and training to direct service providers.

New Hampshire Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence and its fourteen member agencies provide crisis intervention, emergency shelter, victim advocacy, support groups and individual counseling as well as information and referrals to crime victims throughout the state.

Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) of New Hampshire recruits, trains, and supervises volunteers to serve as advocates for neglected children in the State's court system.

Northern Human Services in Conway, Colebrook, and Berlin provide professional mental health services and case management to victims of crime, as well as outreach and training to service providers in the north country.

Victims, Inc. provides support and advocacy throughout the state to families of vehicular homicide victims. The organization also serves victims of violent crimes in Rockingham and Strafford Counties with direct support, information, and referrals.

NH Department of Corrections, Victim Services Unit notifies victims of status changes for the offender (within the state correctional system) related to their case.

In the event that federal funds become no longer available, general funds will not be requested to support this program.
