### **Local Government Center Statement on Acceptance of Appeal by NH Supreme Court**

The Local Government Center, and its legal counsel, issued the following statement regarding the acceptance of their Petition for Appeal and the denial of their Motion for Stay by the NH Supreme Court in the Administrative Hearing Process with the NH Bureau of Securities Regulation.

“The Local Government Center is pleased that the New Hampshire Supreme Court has accepted the Appeal in its entirety, and we look forward to presenting our case to the Court,” said Brian Quirk of Preti Flaherty.

LGC’s General Counsel David Frydman added, “We agree with the Supreme Court’s observation that this case is eligible for mediation, and we welcome the opportunity to mediate the case with the Secretary of State’s Office. In the meantime, we fully intend to comply with the Order in an expeditious manner while the Supreme Court hears our Appeal.”
