
EXPLANATION

The Department of Environmental Services Dam Bureau owns and manages 150 parcels of land located throughout the state and totaling approximately 9,500 acres in area. In addition, the Department is responsible for designing and implementing all repair and reconstruction projects on all 274 State-owned dams, which are either owned in fee or easement. This course will give Mr. Bell, who is the Department's Chief Surveyor, a fuller understanding of the physical and legal issue involved with property rights abutting tidal waters.

Mr. Bell is required to sign a contract, which obligates him to work for the State for six months after satisfactory completion of the courses. He must also complete and achieve a passing grade. If he does not comply with the terms of the contract, he will be liable for returning the amount paid. It should be noted that the course would not be taken on State time. The course he will be taking is directly related to his responsibilities as the Department's Chief Surveyor.

This tuition assistance has been a very successful program of the department and has resulted in many benefits to the State. The cost is minimal when compared to the cost of salary and benefits. The course being taken directly relates to the individual and their job accountabilities, and we have found that this program is an excellent way to train individuals so they can keep up with the latest developments in their work. We have encouraged Mr. Bell to take these courses as part of our professional development plan.



THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE
EDUCATIONAL TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this 17 day of July 20 13 by and through
the Department of Environmental Services (hereinafter referred to as the "State) and
Patrick Bell
hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient").

The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of \$795.00, which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in:

CE 4700 Coastal Water Boundaries

which course(s) is being offered by University of Wyoming and which course(s)
shall commence on August 26 20 13 and terminate on December 10, 20 13


2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.
3. Should the Recipient fail to complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.
4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue in the employ of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of six (6) months.
5. The Recipient shall work in any area of the State to which he/she may be assigned, provided that such assignment will not constitute a severe hardship to said Recipient.
6. Should the Recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in paragraphs 4 and 5, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course(s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.
7. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.

- 8. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.


