

EXPLANATION

The Algebra I-Part II class is a continuation of the Algebra I-Part 1 class previously approved by the Governor and Council and completed by Tiffani Coriaty. The Algebra I-Part II class will provide Tiffani with the knowledge of rational expressions, systems of linear equations, and applications of algebra.

The College Algebra class topics include quadratic and higher degree equations; radical, exponential, and logarithmic equations; graphs of functions; models and applications of functions; and trigonometry. These courses will improve Tiffani's continued growth and performance as an employee of the New Hampshire Lottery. The Algebra I-Part II class and College Algebra class are prerequisites for her accounting degree. The employee will be attending these courses on her own personal time and will be responsible for payment of required books and other materials. A fully executed tuition agreement is attached for your review.

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

EDUCATIONAL TUITION AGREEMENT

AGREEMENT dated this 7th day of May 2014 by and through the New Hampshire Lottery Commission (hereinafter referred to as the "State") and, Tiffani Coriaty (hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient").

The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

1. The State shall pay to the named institution(s) the sum \$1,808.00 which monies shall be used for the sole purpose of enrolling the Recipient in: Algebra I-Part II, and College Algebra, said courses are being offered by NHTI, Concord's Community College, 31 College Drive, Concord, New Hampshire. The Algebra I-Part II course shall commence on June 2, 2014 and will terminate on August 8, 2014. The College Algebra course shall commence on September 2, 2014 and will terminate on December 19, 2014.

2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.

3. Should the Recipient fail to complete and achieve a passing grade in course named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall pay to the State the sum set forth in paragraph 1, provided, however, that if more than one course is named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.

4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the course(s) named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue in the employ of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for the period of five months.

5. The Recipient shall work in any area of the State to which he/she may be assigned, provided that such assignment will not constitute a severe hardship to said Recipient.

6. Should the Recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in paragraphs 4 and 5, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the

Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named courses are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.

7. The Recipient shall not raise any set off or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.

8. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorneys" fees.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the representatives of the State, in his/her official capacity only, and without personal liability, and the Recipient, have hereunto set their hand on the date first above written.

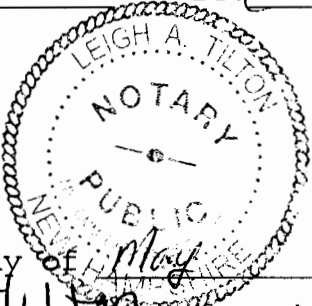
