EXPLANATION

John (Jay) Pedone is currently an Accountant III at the New Hampshire Lottery Commission. The Capital Budgeting and Financing course will provide John with the knowledge needed in his position as a financial manager and will cover advanced topics in capital investment, including determination of cash flows, capital budgeting under risk, replacement decisions, and inflation and capital decisions. The second half of the course focuses on capital financing and structure and includes topics in financial leverage, financing sources, dividend policy, cost of capital and valuation. This course will improve John's continued growth and performance in his current position as Accountant III at the New Hampshire Lottery. This course is a required core course for his Master's Degree in Accounting and Finance. The employee will be attending the course on his own personal time and will be responsible for payment of required books and other materials.

EDUCATION TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this <u>2</u> day of <u>November</u> 20 <u>15</u> by and through the New Hampshire Lottery Commission (hereinafter referred to the "State" and <u>John (Jay) Pedone</u> hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient").
The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:
 The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of \$1,881.00 , which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in: Capital Budgeting and Financing, which course(s) is being offered by Southern New Hampshire University and which course (s) shall commence on December 14, 2015 and terminate on February 28, 2016. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1. Should the recipient fail to complete or achieve a grade of B or better in each course named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall pay to the State the sum set forth in paragraph 1, provided, however, that if more than one course is named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue to be an employee of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of 6 months. Should the recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in the paragraphs above, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course (s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.
