



STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE **PROHIBITED ACTS WHILE VOTING**

(RSA 659:35)

No voter shall allow his or her ballot to be seen by any person with the intention of letting it be known how they are about to vote.

No voter shall place a distinguishing mark upon their ballot. No voter shall write in any name as the candidate of their choice with the intention of thereby placing a distinguishing mark upon the ballot.

No voter shall use or attempt to use any ballot not given to them by the ballot clerk to accomplish any of the acts or purposes prohibited above.

RSA 659:35, IV. Any person willfully violating any of the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a violation.
