#A Authorized the Division of Public Works Design and Construction to enter into a contract amendment with ECS, Inc. Brentwood, NH for the Steam Conversion at the Main Annex and Twitchell Buildings at Hugh Gallen State Office Park South, Concord, NH, which was approved by G&C on September 27, 2017 by increasing the base contract amount by \$414,706 from \$2,236,714 to \$2,651,420.
