EXPLANATION

Pursuant to RSA 494:3, V, the Judicial Council is tasked with serving “as a catalyst for the discussion of legal and judicial issues through seminars, forums and special studies, and any other means, within the limits of available state and private funding.” The Judicial Council received a \$2,000 Justice Grant from the New Hampshire Bar Foundation’s Stanley M. and Thalia M. Brown Fund. The purpose of this grant is to educate new state legislators about the criminal justice system. This funding will pay for a nationally recognized speaker who will address the critical role of the 6th Amendment right to counsel. The remaining grant money will pay for refreshments for attendees. Any remaining funds will be returned to the New Hampshire Bar Foundation.

Funds are to be used as follows:

020 Current Expenses:	Up to \$1,000 will be spent on refreshments during the training.
066 Training:	\$1,000 will be spent on a speaker/trainer.
