Requested Action


Pursuant to RSA 106-B:18, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to restore 30.60 hours of sick leave to a New Hampshire State Trooper who suffered a line of duty injury and was unable to perform his normal or routine duties from February 20, 2018 through March 3, 2018. Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Explanation

On February 19, 2018, the Trooper responded to a domestic disturbance call. While on scene, he was struck in the face and struck several more times in the back of his head causing him to lose consciousness. He was transported to a nearby hospital where he was diagnosed with a concussion. The Trooper was unable to return to work, but was eventually cleared for full duty and returned to work on March 4, 2018. This resulted in the use of his sick leave.

The Trooper's convalescent time required the use of 30.6 hours of sick leave that we are seeking authorization to have restored to him.
