The Department of Information Technology requests to place an item on the consent calendar.

EXPLANATION

The Department requests authorization to accept this gift valued at \$1,975.00. Denis Goulet, Commissioner/CIO will participate as a panelist at the CIO Roundtable in Scottsdale, AZ. Texas Technology Consortium and the Center for Technology provide educational and networking opportunities among peers in a small, invitation-only venue. Texas Technology Consortium will cover all costs for Mr. Goulet to attend the Roundtable and serve as a panelist during the event.

This will be the 20th event hosted by the nonprofits. According to past attendees, the value in attending is that it provides a forum where state executives choose the strategic issue topics that are most important to them and have the opportunity to discuss with their peers how they are addressing those, share best practices, and discuss hurdles that need to be overcome.

The event begins on Sunday, December 2, at 6 pm with a welcome reception and dinner. Monday, December 3, is an all-day Roundtable session and a teambuilding exercise followed by a reception and dinner. The Roundtable panel discussions conclude by noon on Tuesday, December 4, followed by an optional afternoon group outing and farewell dinner, which Mr. Goulet plans to attend. 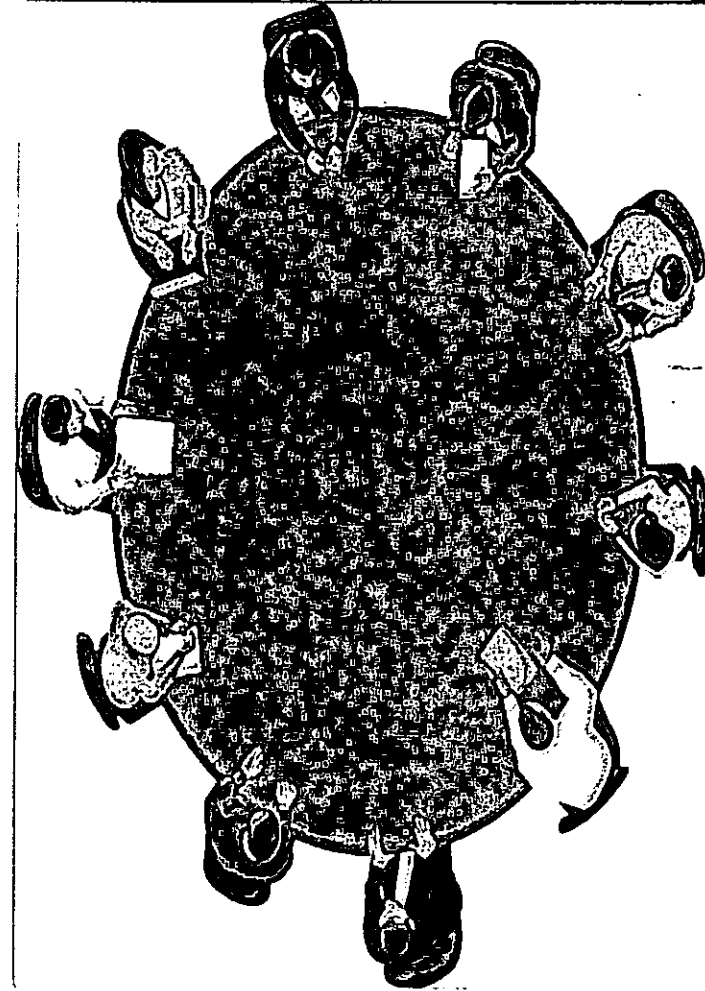
