**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant an annual salary increment to Frederick J. Lulka, Criminal Investigator (Position #9U376, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2611-014-500134) from a salary level of \$71,594.64 (LG BB, Step 5) to a salary level of \$75,297.56 (LG BB, Step 6); effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or November 23, 2018, whichever is the latter.

**EXPLANATION**

In accordance with NH RSA 94:1-a, I(a), Mr. Lulka is eligible for a salary increment, subject to the approval of the Governor and Executive Council.
