DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES

#A. The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor Kenney, seconded by Councilor Pappas, authorized the Division of Parks and Recreation, Cannon Mountain Ski Area, to select as **sole source**, a new Prinoth Bison S. Tier Snow Groomer to be used for mountain ski operations financed through an equipment lease agreement with Signature Public Funding Corp. Effective upon G&C approval. **100% Agency Income.** (2) Further authorize the exercise a second yearly equipment lease financing option by entering into a Tax Exempt Equipment Lease Financing Agreement with Signature Public Funding Corp., Greenwich, CT, in the total amount of \$370,612.69 for a 4-year annual lease schedule for the new Prinoth Bison S Tier Snow Groomer. Effective upon G&C approval through November 15, 2022, with the option to seek yearly equipment lease financing with SPFC for subsequent equipment lease schedules over the next 2 years upon G&C approval. The original Tax Exempt Equipment Lease Financing Agreement was approved by G&C on 12-7-16, item #43. **100% Agency Income.**
