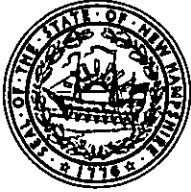

REQUESTED ACTION

EXPLANATION

This course, Introduction to Chemical Principles, will benefit Ms. Haley and the Department as it is a precursor to enrollment into the registered nursing program. The course offers a conceptual introduction to the basic principles related to the structure of matter and the nature of chemical reactions. Particular attention will be given to the types of reactions that apply to the health field. Advancing her education will increase the level of care she is able to provide for the residents of Glenclyff Home.

Jill Haley has been employed by the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), Glenclyff Home for sixteen (16) years and is currently a Licensed Practical Nurse. Her duties entail providing direct care to the residents of Glenclyff Home. This includes, but is not limited to: applying dressings; giving prescribed medication; observing, recording and reporting signs and symptoms of patient condition to other nursing personnel or to a physician; counseling patients regarding recovery progress and treatments ordered; checking eating habits and general welfare. It further entails keeping detailed records of all work and activities on ward or unit including ordering drugs, narcotics and other medical supplies as necessary. She may also participate in developing and maintaining health care plans for individual patients. Successful completion of the program will add to the overall strength of the Department to perform its mission to the residents of New Hampshire.

The Department of Health and Human Services encourages and supports employees who wish to further their professional growth through continuing education in disciplines that are mutually advantageous.

This course will not be taken on State time.

THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE
EDUCATIONAL TUITION AGREEMENT

Agreement dated this 21st day of November 2018 by and through the Department of Health and Human Services (hereinafter referred to as the "State) and Jill W. Haley (hereinafter referred to as the "Recipient"). The State and the Recipient do hereby mutually agree as follows:

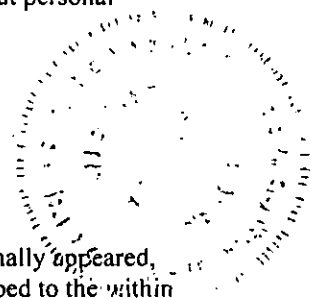
- 1. The State shall pay to the named institution the sum of \$430.00, which monies shall be used for the purpose of enrolling the Recipient in: Introduction to Chemical Principles (course name), which course(s) is being offered by River Valley Community College and which course(s) shall commence on January 22, 2019 and terminate on May 10, 2019.
2. The Recipient shall complete and achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1.
3. Should the Recipient fail to complete or achieve a passing grade in each course named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall pay to the State the sum set forth in paragraph 1, provided, however, that if more than one course is named in paragraph 1, the amount which shall be paid to the State shall be calculated on a pro rata basis.
4. Upon the satisfactory completion of the courses named in paragraph 1, the Recipient shall continue in the employ of the State in his/her current position (or in such other position, at equal or greater compensation, to which he/she may be assigned) for a period of six (6) months.
5. The Recipient shall work in any area of the State to which he/she may be assigned, provided that such assignment will not constitute a severe hardship to said Recipient.
6. Should the Recipient breach any of the conditions set forth in paragraphs 4 and 5, the Recipient shall pay to the State a sum equal to all monies previously paid by the State for the Recipient pursuant to the Agreement, provided, however, that the Recipient shall receive a credit for each month in which he/she is employed by the State subsequent to the date upon which the named course(s) are satisfactorily completed, the value of said credit to be calculated on a pro rata basis.
7. The Recipient shall not raise any setoff or counterclaim against the State in any action brought by the State to collect any amount due under this agreement.
8. Should any amount be found to be due the State in any action brought against the Recipient pursuant to this Agreement, the State shall, in addition to said amount, be entitled to an award of costs and a reasonable amount in "attorney" fees.
