REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the New Hampshire Liquor Commission with the authorization of the Office of the Governor, respectfully requests approval of an annual salary step increase for Mark C. Armaganian, Director, Division of Enforcement and Licensing, (Unclassified Position # 9U572), in the amount of \$5,089.76 from Grade GG, Step 6 (\$103,059.32) to Grade GG, Step 7, with a new annual salary of \$108,149.08, effective January 18, 2019, upon Governor and Executive Council approval. Funding 100% Liquor Funds.

EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3, "Yearly Service Increases" states, in part, that "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/5 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established."

Director Mark C. Armaganian was appointed to his position on April 5, 2017 and he is eligible to advance to the next step on the salary scale. As the Director, he is responsible for all activities related to liquor law enforcement and licensing in the Liquor Commission's Enforcement and Licensing Division, with responsibility for state-wide education, enforcement, and licensing according to the state alcohol, beverage, and tobacco laws.
