Wes Habley – ACT Director of State Organizations discussed the change of the leadership structure with each state organization and how the process evolved. The history of the ACT organization, growth, future development and research was shared with enthusiasm. Demonstration of the new State Organization website.

New England Executive officers (Roger Forando, Rick Hilton, and Bob Quist) spoke about the positive results in their states for students using the ACT tools that measure student progress toward readiness. All members provided examples of success and their commitment to the ACT benefits to students and schools.

Michael Monson – ACT Consultant for the Northeast Region shared updates about the ACT (students will now need to upload a photo with their registration).

NEW HAMPSHIRE STATE COUNCIL

Members Present: Dan Wells, Robyn Mahoney, Lisa Partridge, Eugene Fox, Ken Relihan, Christine Leach, Tim Pratt, Blake Curwen (ACT Director)

- Ken Relihan explained that the NH Commissioner had asked him to join and attend the state org. but that this would likely be his final meeting. He stated that he needed to remain 'neutral' with ACT/SAT and thus could not take on any of the open positions. He also expressed concern about the small group and the lack of 'burning' issues in NH.
- Dan Wells stated that the smaller group would be a good thing in terms of making quick, actionable decisions.
- **Began elections:** Dan and Christine were along on the ballots for State Representative, Chair, Robin Mahoney, Lisa Partridge self-elected as new Chair-Elect, and Secretary.
- Blake talked about other state's initiatives and funding and promised to send some examples from other established regions.
- Group talked about expanding the NH State Org. to bridge the education conversation between both public and private schools and secondary and postsecondary contacts.
- Ken talked about getting the Governor's education head involved in the ACT conversation and stated that he could likely send information about CCRW's to principals/supers through the NH 'Key Messages' email sent from the DOE.
- Group talked about the advantages of taking the ACT 'in lieu' of SAT subject tests and Blake said he would follow up with the list of schools for the group.
- Tim Pratt expressed potential interest in learning more about PLAN, group discussed administration of PLAN/PSAT.
- Blake talked about including an organization member in the state level meeting with the DOE/Commissioner
