A letter from the owner of the Terramarascae Cherry Farm, Denis Rubic,

I am happy to hear that the 15th Transatlantic Leadership Forum of the State Legislative Leaders Foundation will be in Croatia this year. It is a great honour for me to welcome you and the participants of the study trip on your way from Zagreb to Dubrovnik on our organic Marasca-plantation based in the heart of the Dalmatian hinterland.

In the beginning, 2007, there existed a unique idea and love for the marasca sour cherry (lat. Prunus cerasus marasca), which has a 500-year long tradition in Dalmatia. The vision of „Terra Marascae“ (lat. Land of the marasca cherry) is to advance the ecological cultivation of the marasca sour cherry and to create high value products from the gifts provided by Mother Nature. In a UNDP-projects report for Croatia, the marasca has been declared probably the best quality sour cherry in the world. It has been known throughout the ages as a “food and medicine” due to its antioxidant action, very high concentration of melatonin and the highest dry mass content of cherries worldwide. This is one of the reasons why we receive almost daily inquiries from a lot of countries and thus also from California.

A total of 50 of 160 hectares have already been cultivated and the first 22,000 trees have been planted enjoying 2,500 hours of sunlight annually. We can state that we are the largest organic

marasca-plantation on Planet Earth, as far as we know.

On our website, www.terramarascae.eu, interested persons can find information about our project, including possibilities of cooperation and investment. In this context I would like to highlight that we have about 100 "Cherry Godfathers" so far from all over Europe.

I hope that you and our friends from the United States will have a very pleasant stay in Croatia.

I look forward to seeing you all in July.
