Please see the information below from Lennox for the Webinar on the NCSDAE Hill Briefings that is scheduled for Wednesday, February 19, 2014 at 3:00 pm ET. Let me know if you cannot participate at that time. Some of you are still identifying another adult educator from your state to participate in the Hill visits. Please pass this communication on to the person that will be representing you.

We are going forward with the visits on Feb. 27, 28 and March 6,7. Choose whichever date works best for your schedule. Here is the basic schedule for each two day event. Arrive in DC on Feb. 27 or March 6 in time for 6:00 pm dinner/briefing at the hotel. The hotel information will be sent to you within a few days. The actual hill visits should be scheduled for the mornings of Feb. 28, March 7 with people flying back home that afternoon/evening.

The members of Congress that we are targeting are listed below. Some of you have three members of Congress to contact. For others, after you schedule you visit (20-30 minutes) with the staff of the designated member of Congress below you may have time to meet with the staff of another member if that would work with your travel plans. Let me know if you would like some guidance on what other member of your state's delegation might be visited. Keep in mind that you will probably be meeting with staff, since many members of Congress are not in their office on Fridays.

The focus of all of our visits is on the Need, Success and Impact of adult education in our states. We should bring any state fact sheets that would help staff understand what we do. We will discuss those information packages on the Webinar.

The National Council of State Directors will cover all of the expenses associated with these two events. You should make your flight arrangements and hotel reservations (as soon as I get you the hotel information). The National Council will reimburse you for those costs as well as meals, airport parking, mileage, taxi, etc.

Please contact the staff person in the offices below to set up your visit time. If you do not have a current contact you should ask for the member's staff that is responsible for adult education legislation/funding.
