



● **Call To Order**

- Jeremy Olson called to order the regular meeting of the NHLA at 1:38 PM.

● **Roll Call**

- Jeremy Olson conducted roll call. *(All board members present at the time of the roll call are marked with an asterisk (*).)*

● **Treasurer's Report – Dennis Corrigan**

- Treasurer gave some correspondence to Amanda from some charities
- Treasurer's report handed out
- Kevin moved to accept Treasurer's report; Jeremy seconded - MA VV
- Dennis thanked Steve for helping him in his transition
- Dennis pointed out we need to have his acceptance as Treasurer in the minutes, for the bank records
- Nondesignated donations - Dennis asked about where to send these donations. Cheques are often not designated as ops, PAC, or otherwise
 - Emily said default is to the PAC
 - Steve said although, if they donate >\$100 and won't give the required info, it goes to ops
- Jeremy moved that this be the policy (donations >\$100 without designation or the required info for the PAC goes to ops), Emily seconded - MA VV

● **Membership Director's Report – Emily Sandblade**

- Members: 97 lifetime; 44 full; 282 basics = 423 members
- Emily wants to get CivicRM up and running before Facebook tie-in
- Amanda asked about if there was still a FB problem where no1 can post to the "Wall"
 - Kevin changed this - it was that way due to spammers & obnoxious people w/ extreme opinions
 - Now that there is approval-by-admin mode available (FB just added this), that is the mode the FB site is using
 - There are 20 admins
 - Discussion about problems with non-Board member admins
 - Extended discussion as to FB details
- Melissa and Eileen arrived at 1:54 ---
 - Jeremy moved that FB admins be restricted to Board members plus people approved thereby for special projects or purposes
 - Kevin seconded - MA VV
- LegIT, now has a feature for amendments – we can't implement during bill review season. Test in Parallel before rolling out. We could make a read only version of the current bill review for future reference.
- Need to get all the IT people together and make a list of the needed changes. IT Meeting scheduled second Sunday of March 9th.
