REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of Parks and Recreation (Department) to make a **RETROACTIVE** payment to Kilbco Plumbing and Heating (VC #308165), Tilton, NH, for \$12,000 for replacement of two hot water tanks in the bathhouse at Dry River Campground in Crawford Notch State Park per invoices dated July 30, 2019. 100% Agency Income

Funds to support this request are anticipated to be available in the following account in FY 2020 upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget.

EXPLANATION

In July of 2019, the hot water system for the bathhouse at Dry River Campground in Crawford Notch State Park failed. The campground was near capacity and this is the only facility at the park offering showers. The Central Region Manager and the Park Manager deemed the lack of hot water to be an emergency. Three contractors were contacted to see if they could repair or replace the system but only Kilbco Plumbing and Heating (Kilbco) was available immediately. Kilbco was able to replace the two hot water tanks and had the bathhouse operational again very quickly. Due to this emergency repair, the Department is now seeking retroactive approval to make payment to the vendor.
