EXPLANATION

The Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Medicaid Business and Policy, Bureau of Developmental Services seeks approval to accept and expend federal funds in the amount of \$70,069,998 from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

Under New Hampshire Law, public schools are required to provide certain medical services and supports to students with special education needs. The Medicaid to Schools Program enables schools to seek partial reimbursement for medically related, non-educational, expenses for Medicaid eligible students.

The services provided are to public school students who have special education needs specified in his/her Individualized Education Plan (IEP) and also are eligible for Medicad. Such services include: Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech, Language and Hearing Services, Nursing Services, Psychiatric and Psychological Services, Mental Health Services, Vision Services, Specialized Transportation to Obtain Covered Services, Medical Exams and Evaluations, Pre-school Services, Rehabilitative Assistance, Supplies and Equipment related to vision, speech, language and hearing services, occupational and physical therapy services.

The school districts are enrolled as Medicaid Providers. The school districts submit claims to New Hamsphire Medicaid for eligible services by qualified staff, as outlined in He-M1301. The school districts receive fifty percent of their actual cost or fifty percent of the Medicaid rate established by the State of New Hampshire, whichever is less.

This accounting unit has traditionally been budgeted and was included in the Agency Efficiency budget and the Governor's Recommended budget. The funding was taken out in both the House and Senate phases with the expectation that the Department would request the reinstatement of funding from the Fiscal Committee.
