#### **REQUESTED ACTION**

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with East Coast Signals, Inc. (Vendor 162234) of Deerfield, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$325,154.00 for retrofitting all signal head backplates at ninety-one intersections in the southeast quadrant of the state with 2" fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders, from the date of Governor and Council approval through May 18, 2018 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available as follows for FY 2017, and is contingent upon the availability and continued appropriation of fund for FY 2018:

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$22,760.78 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 7% of the contract amount.

#### **EXPLANATION**

This project is part of the State's Ten Year Transportation Improvement Plan, under the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) and the Intersection Safety Improvement Plan (ISIP). The project retrofits all signal head backplates at ninety-one intersections in the southeast quadrant of the state with 2" fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders. This will be accomplished by replacing outdated signal heads with new heads including backplates with fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders, replacing

damaged or unacceptable backplates with new backplates with fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders, or adding fluorescent yellow retroreflective tape to existing backplates.

The project is part of a recommended series of intersection improvements as described in the Intersection Safety Improvement Plan. This project will provide 2" fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders on signal heads for improved visibility and safety as well as provide minor corrections to meet MUTCD compliance. This project, Phase Two of Three, will upgrade 91 (all state maintained) signalized intersections in the southeast quadrant of the State. Phase One completed upgrades to 90 signalized intersections in the central quadrant of the State.

The Contingency amount is proposed to be 7% of the contract amount. Due to the nature of the retrofit work required under this contract as well as the number and diversity of project locations, there could be items unaccounted for to complete some installations.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 90% federal funds with 10% state match. Turnpike toll credit is being utilized for match requirements, effectively using 100% federal funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

## **SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET**

**DESCRIPTION:** The project retrofits all signal head backplates at ninety-one intersections in the southeast quadrant of the state with 2" fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders. This will be accomplished by replacing outdated signal heads with new heads including backplates with fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders, replacing damaged or unacceptable backplates with new backplates with fluorescent yellow retroreflective borders, or adding fluorescent yellow retroreflective tape to existing backplates.

**FEDERAL FUNDING:** The improvements for the project are funded from the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) with 90% Federal Funding and the 10% match being Turnpike Toll Credits.

**CONTINGENCY:** The Contingency amount is proposed to be 7% of the contract amount. Due to the nature of the retrofit work required under this contract as well as the number and diversity of project locations, there could be items unaccounted for to complete some installations.

**PROJECT INITIATED:** Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) and Intersection Safety Improvement Plan (ISIP)

**PROJECT EXPLANATION:** The project is part of a recommended series of intersection improvements as described in the Intersection Safety Improvement Plan.
