Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Christina M. Wilson as an Assistant Attorney General (Position 9U605, Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2623-013-500132), from a salary level of \$64,500 to a salary level of \$71,000 **retroactive** to July 1, 2019 upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

**EXPLANATION**

In accordance with the 2001 N.H. Laws Chapter 158, Section 101, and 2018 N.H. Laws Chapter 162, Section 14, this request seeks your approval to grant a salary increase for Assistant Attorney General Christina M. Wilson. This item is **retroactive** because funds in the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 biennium budget were not available to submit this request prior to July 1, 2019.

Ms. Wilson is a resident of Concord. She received her law degree from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2016. Prior to joining the Department of Justice, Ms. Wilson interned at the New Hampshire Supreme Court as a Judicial Clerk from August 2015 through December 2015, and was a Superior Court law clerk from August 2016 through August 2018. In August 2018 she joined the Department as an attorney in the Transportation and Construction Bureau and was appointed as an Assistant Attorney General on August 16, 2019. Ms. Wilson's salary will increase by \$6,500, from \$64,500 to \$71,000. I will continue her assignment with the Transportation and Construction Bureau.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General,
