3. Hearing held at 10:00 a.m. motion to table hearing to 10:00 a.m. made by Michael Little, seconded by Joseph Shanley, meeting to adjourn and reconvene after the hearing.
In the Hearing of Karen M. Martin vs. Adam Whitcomb and Brian Whitcomb. Docket Number 00-06 the Board found:
Adam Whitcomb guilty of violation of RSA 311-B, II(c) and (g), after deliberations a motion was made by Michael Little, and seconded by Joseph Shanley to suspend the license of Adam Whitcomb for one year, to be followed by a one year probation period with the stipulation that if one more complaint is adjudicated against him during the probation period his license will be revoked.
Adam Whitcomb complied by August 30, 2001 with the sanction documentation requirement pertaining to Docket No. 00-04.
Brian Whitcomb, whose license was suspended on March 19, 2001 by order of The Board in Docket Number 00-05, was found not guilty of RSA 311-B:4, engaging in auctioneering for a fee or commission without a license.
