

BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS MINUTES
Legislative Office Building Room 307, Concord, NH
July 11, 2016, 9:00 a.m.

1. The Board of Auctioneers convened at 9:00 a.m. with, Chairman Gregory J. Walsh, Vice-Chairman Roy W. Tilsley, Secretary Gregory J. Peverly, Member Russell R. Abbott and Member Robert P. Secord present.
2. The Board on motion of Russell R. Abbott, seconded by Robert P. Secord accepted the minutes of the June 6, 2016 meeting.
3. The Board on motion of Russell R. Abbott, seconded by Robert P. Secord, and further on a roll call vote as follows: Gregory J. Walsh – yes, Roy W. Tilsley – yes, Gregory J.
