

Dear Mr. Secretary of State Gardner:

Please be informed that I represent Keith Hirschmann a candidate for state representative from Hillsborough District 17 in Manchester, NH. As you are already aware **RSA 656:16 states: "... The names of all candidates shall be printed in uniform type..."** As you are already aware the issue concerning the absentee ballots was not resolved prior to the election. Although you did change the ballots for the General Election the absentee ballots were not changed to reflect the small print concern. My clients' right to a fair election was therefore not preserved and my client's constitutional rights to a fair and equal election were also not preserved.

My client respectfully requests that he be given a new election. Based on your opinion to do so, my client did undergo a recount of the ballots. He now wants the challenged and missing ballot issues to be resolved by the Ballot Law Commission. The ballots as constructed, call into question the election process and was surely a violation of his rights. Please be informed that my client, if after the challenged ballots issues are resolved and he still does not come up with enough votes to win a seat, wants a new election in his District. Thank you. 
Dear Clerk ,

Please at your earliest convenience in accordance to State law , have my complaint heard by the New Hampshire Ballot Law Commission . My name is Representative Keith "coach" Hirschmann , I am an Incumbent legislator from Hillsborough district 17 which represents three Manchester wards 10 , 11 ,and 12.

On the advice of my attorney Charles Douglas III , I am writing to complain of non - uniform ballots used in the election Of November 7<sup>th</sup> 2006.

Title LXIII Elections of New Hampshire Law , Section 656:16 Clearly indicates that uniformity of print type shall be used with the printing of all names . My name was the only one printed In a smaller unreadable font sent to absentee voters , while other candidates names were printed in a Larger text. The results were seniors could not read my name resulting in lost votes which caused me to Lose by a very close margin on election day. Also the ballots used on election day at the polls were of Normal text meaning two different ballots were used in the same election , and to add to the confusion The sample ballots posted at the polling location were my name in smaller unreadable text and not the Same as the ballot handed to each voter that day. We ask you void the results in my race and award a New election with uniform ballots as stated in new Hampshire law.
