REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 4:39-c and 228:31, authorize the Department of Transportation to sell a 5.63 +/- acre parcel of State owned land located on the easterly side of NH Route 125 in the Town of Kingston to Joseph Wilson for \$58,900.00 plus an \$1,100.00 Administrative Fee, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

It has been determined by the Division of Finance that this parcel was originally purchased with 80% Federal Funds and 20% Highway Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Department would like to sell a parcel of State owned land located on the easterly side of NH Route 125 in the Town of Kingston.

This parcel is the combination of two (2) contiguous parcels acquired for use as a sand/gravel pit. Also a portion of this parcel is encumbered with a 170' wide Public Service of New Hampshire utility easement.

This parcel is accessed by a State owned Class VI highway purchased in the 1960's in connection with the construction of NH Route 125 through this area which is a Limited Access facility and also by Small Pox Road.

This request has been reviewed by this Department and it has been determined that the requested area is surplus to its operational needs and interest.

The Long Range Capital Planning and Utilization Committee at their June 6, 2018 meeting approved this request that the Department sell a 5.63 +/- acre parcel of State owned land located on the easterly side of NH Route 125 in the Town of Kingston by a sealed bid process to the general public with a minimum bid price of \$35,100.00 (\$34,000.00 plus an Administrative Fee of \$1,100.00).

In accordance with RSA 4:39-c, the Town of Kingston has been offered this property at the approved purchase price and they did not express an interest in purchasing the property. The New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority was also offered the property at the approved price in accordance with RSA 204-D:2 and they did not express an interest in purchasing the property.

The Department notified the abutters of this property of the sale of this parcel by a sealed bid process. Also the Department advertised in local and statewide newspapers the sale of this property by a sealed bid process with a minimum bid of \$35,100.00 with bids to be opened November 29, 2018. Two (2) bids were received as listed below:





Upon receipt of the total bid and approval by the Governor and Executive Council, the Department will issue a Quitclaim Deed, subject to final review and approval by the Department of Transportation.

A certified check [Bid Security] in the amount of ten (10%) percent of my bid is attached hereto. I/We shall submit the balance within thirty (30) days upon Governor and Executive Council Approval, which takes approximately four (4) to six (6) weeks after the bid opening. I/We further understand that if the balance of the bid has not been received within thirty (30) days of Governor and Executive Council approval that the bid may be forfeited and the State shall have the right to re-advertise for sale or award the bid to the subsequent bidder.

I/We further understand and agree that if I/We are the successful bidder that the Bid Security as well as the balance of the bid are non-refundable if I/we am/are unable to meet the terms of this Agreement.
