### Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Safety (DOS), Division of State Police, to accept and expend funds from the US Department of Transportation, Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the amount of \$256,059.00 for the purpose of creating a single integrated system to serve as the core data exchange system to be used by the Division of State Police Commercial Enforcement. Effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2021.  
Funding Source: 100% Federal Funds

### Explanation

These grant funds will be used to implement the Commercial Vehicle Information Exchange Window (CVIEW) project to create a single integrated system allowing troopers to access multiple federal and state commercial motor vehicle databases, state credentialing, and to improve data sharing across agencies and jurisdictions.

The CVIEW system will serve as the core Commercial Vehicle Operation (CVO) data exchange system in New Hampshire, exchanging data with the State's multiple CVO-related systems and agencies and the national Safety and Fitness Electronic Records (SAFER) system.

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Implementation of this project will:

- Improve data collection to ensure the safety of motor carriers, commercial vehicles and drivers, cargo, and passengers.
- Improve real-time data sharing with the State and other jurisdictions' information such as inspection reports and credentials status to identify high risk and unsafe carriers, vehicles, and drivers.
- Import data to an inspection report to improve inspection accuracy and timeliness.
- Provide a dashboard to access multiple queries, through a single portal, such as International Fuel Tax/International Registration Plan (IFTA/IRP); Unified Carrier Registration (UCR); Out-of-Service Order, and Inspection Safety Score Data (ISS), thereby improving efficiency for a trooper roadside.
- Provide a query portal for carriers, limited to individual accounts only.
- With better data, allow enforcement personnel to deploy a more strategic use of enforcement resources to improve CMV safety on NH roadways.
- Provide time savings for carriers through faster inspections.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Funds in Class 038, Technology-Software, are needed to pay for the first year of maintenance of the software.

Funds in Class 040, Indirect Costs, are needed to pay indirect costs on eligible expenses.

Funds in Class 041, Audit Fund Set Aside, represent the associated amount for this request.

Funds in Class 050, Personal Service-Temp, are needed to pay for the time spent performing tasks related to the development of the project. This is an existing filled position.

Funds in Class 060, Benefits, are needed to pay benefits associated with Class 050.

Funds in Class 103, Contracts for Operational Services, are needed to pay for the procurement, configuration, deployment, and training for the implementation of the CVIEW system.

These funds were not budgeted because the grant award was received after the submission of the Department's SFY 2020/21 biennial budget request and the final allocation between classes was not yet known.

In the event that Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds and/or Highway Funds will not be requested to support this program.
