Requested Item

Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, with the authorization of the Office of the Governor, respectfully requests approval of an annual salary step increase for Mark Doyle, Director of the Division of Emergency Services, Communications, and Management (unclassified position #9U524), in the amount of \$5,699.72 from Grade II, Step 5 (\$109,525.00) to Grade II, Step 6, with a new annual salary of \$115,224.72, effective from June 9, 2018.

Explanation

RSA 94:3 "Yearly Service Increases", states, in part, that "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/5 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established".

Mr. Doyle was appointed to his position on June 9, 2017 and was eligible to advance to the next step on the salary scale on June 9, 2018. As Director of Emergency Services, Communications, and Management, he is responsible for the operations, maintenance, and technical support of the NH E-911 system and other emergency communications. He is hardworking and dedicated to the Division's goal of serving as the communications link between the public and public safety agencies, especially connecting emergency callers with responders throughout the State. With over 32 years of experience in police work, serving seven of those years as a police chief, Mr. Doyle has firsthand experience responding to emergencies and brings to this position a unique understanding of the various aspects of emergency communications.
