REQUESTED ACTION

For inclusion on the Governor and Council Consent Calendar, pursuant to MOP 1200, I.D., authorize the New Hampshire Lottery Commission (Lottery) to pay the North American Association of State and Provincial Lotteries (NASPL) (VC #206566), Concord, Ohio, the amount of \$20,000 for Calendar Year 2020 membership dues effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020. **100% Lottery Funds.**

EXPLANATION

The NASPL membership facilitates communication among lottery organizations regarding development of industry standards and matters of mutual interest, particularly those which relate to the integrity, security and efficiency of state and provincial lottery jurisdictions. 7. Is the membership required to receive any federal grants or required in order to receive or participate in licensing or certification exams? Explain. *No.*



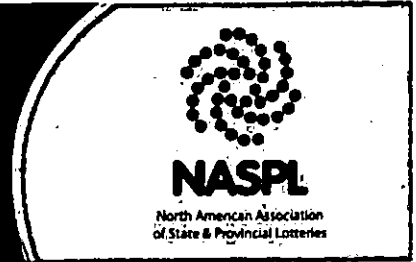
