EXPLANATION

Resume of military service pertaining to Captain Martin F. Isabelle:

Captain Isabelle enlisted in the active army on November 14, 2000. He served as an Infantryman on active duty and attained the rank of Sergeant. While on active duty he was deployed to Afghanistan and Iraq. Captain Isabelle was then selected to attend Officer Candidate School. After successful completion, he was commissioned on August 18, 2005. His first assignment was as the Battalion S2 for the 75th Ranger Regiment Special Troops Battalion. Captain Isabelle's next assignment was as the Battalion Intelligence Officer for the same unit. He was then assigned as the Regimental Assistant Intelligence Officer for Headquarters, 75th Ranger Regiment. While assigned there he was responsible for providing all-source intelligence to support planning and executing joint special operations for 2,700 Airborne Rangers. On November 6, 2008 Captain Isabelle transferred to the New Hampshire Army National Guard. His first assignment was as the Commander for Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 3643rd Brigade Support Battalion. After his command, Captain Isabelle was selected as the Senior Training, Advising, and Counseling (TAC) Officer for the Officer Candidate School (OCS). There he is responsible for training, counseling and mentoring Officer Candidates to become future officers in the New Hampshire Army National Guard. Based on his performance, he has been selected as the next commander for the OCS program and for promotion to Major. CPT Isabelle is a graduate of Army Military Intelligence Captains Career Course and possesses a Master of Arts in Philosophy.
