Authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to **retroactively** amend Item #58, approved by Governor and Council on July 2, 2014, and originally approved by Governor and Council (Item #72) on October 2, 2013, for the purpose of reallocating federal funds from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration entitled Border Enforcement Grant Program to ensure that motor carriers and drivers operating commercial motor vehicles (CMV) entering the United States from a foreign country are in compliance with U.S.CMV safety standards and regulations. Effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period ended September 30, 2014. Funding source: 100% Federal Funds.

Explanation

This item is **retroactive** due to a recently discovered miscalculation of the associated benefits, which were calculated at the old rate due to the timing of when the Federal grants were prepared compared to when the grants were received. The Division received approval of the reallocation from the approving Federal Agency on September 29, 2014; subsequently, the Division is submitting this request to Governor and Council at the first available meeting.

These troopers will utilize overtime for traffic enforcement; detection and apprehension of impaired drivers and drivers transporting contraband; conducting safety inspections to ensure that motor carriers and drivers operating CMVs

Class 070 Funds, In-State-Travel - These funds will be used to pay for cruiser fuel, overnight lodging, and meals as approved by the awarding Federal Agency.
