INFORMATIONAL ITEM

Pursuant to RSA 21-P:43, RSA 4:45, RSA 4:47, Executive Order 2020-04, as extended by Executive Order 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10, 2020-14, and 2020-15, Governor Sununu has authorized the Department of Safety, Division of Emergency Services and Communications, to take the following action:

Accept and expend federal pass-through funds in the amount of \$73,578.00 from the NH Department of Justice to support mobile video platform kits in support of COVID-19 testing sites and PPE distribution sites for first responders, effective upon approval through June 30, 2021. Funding Source: 100% Agency Income.

Explanation

These funds will be used by the Statewide Emergency Operations Center to receive and project multiple video sources using the fūsusONE platform. The fūsusONE platform uses secure, encrypted paths for data transmission conforming to the Criminal Justice Information Systems (CJIS) and HIPPA requirements. The fūsusONE system is rapidly deployable to various Alternative Care Medical Sites for situational awareness in support of COVID-19 testing sites and PPE distribution sites for first responders. These funds recently became available to support the COVID-19 response and were therefore not included as part of the Department's SFY20/21 biennial budget.

Funds are to be budgeted as follows:


Class 030 funds, Equipment, are needed for cameras, controllers, and foyers.
