EXPLANATION

The NH Department of Education receives an IDEA-Special Education award authorized under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA Part B). This is a formula grant to states to assist them in providing a free appropriate public education in the least restrictive environment for children with disabilities ages 3 through 21. The IDEA grant requires that the funds be awarded to local educational agencies (LEAs). The purposes of this part are to ensure that all children with disabilities have available to them a free appropriate public education that emphasizes special education and related services designed to meet their unique needs and prepare them for further education, employment, and independent living; To ensure that the rights of children with disabilities and their parents are protected; to assist States, localities, educational service agencies, and Federal agencies to provide for the education of all children with disabilities; and to assess and ensure the effectiveness of efforts to educate children with disabilities.

The following appropriation authorities are being requested:

Class 027 – Trans to DOIT – Additional appropriation needed to pay required OIT expenses.

Class 028 – Trans to GenServ – Additional appropriation needed to pay required General Services expenses.

The following is the information specifically required when transfers are requested, in accordance with the Budget Officer's instructional memorandum dated April 17, 1985, to support the above requested actions.

- A. *Justification:* The transfer consists of transfers to cover the projected deficits in class 027 transfers to DOIT and 027 transfers to General Services (rent) due to the amounts appropriated being lower than anticipated expenditures.
- B. Does this transfer involve continuing programs or one-time projects? Yes. Continuing.
- C. Is this transfer required to maintain existing program levels or will it increase the program level? This transfer is required to maintain existing program levels.
- D. Cite any requirements which make this program mandatory. The NH Department of Education receives an IDEA-Special Education award authorized under Part B of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA Part B).
- E. Identify the source of funds on all accounts listed on this transfer. 100% Federal Funds.
- F. Will-there-be-any-effect-on-revenue-if-this-transfer-if-not-approved?—There is no anticipated effect—on-revenue-as-a-result-of-this-transfer.
- G. Are funds expected to lapse if this transfer is not approved. It is anticipated that no funds will lapse if this transfer is not approved.
- H. Are personnel services involved? There are no personnel services involved.

The Department has conducted a detailed review of these line items in the budget to ensure that available funds are maximized to the greatest degree possible.
