presiding officer to amend the Staff Petition for Relief to change the restitution amount;

WHEREAS, the Motion to Amend was granted on September 17, 2018 and a hearing was held on September 18, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the *Findings, Rulings and Order* issued by the presiding officer dated October 29, 2018 determined the restitution owed to investors, but the amounts determined by the presiding officer was not as previously amended; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau filed a *Motion for Reconsideration* on November 5, 2018

noting the following incorrect amounts in the Findings, Rulings and Order. finding of fact

7 should have been \$30,000; finding of fact 8 should have been \$25,000; finding of fact

10 should have been \$35,000; finding of fact 21(c) should have been \$35,000; and

finding of fact 22 should have represented restitution in the amounts of \$1,000, \$750

and \$7,500; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau's motion requested that the total restitution amount be

amended from \$1,332,500 to \$1,206,250; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau's motion is based on the existing record; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau's motion has not been objected to by the Respondent

THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the *Findings, Rulings and Order* issued by the presiding officer on October 29, 2018 is hereby amend to change the total restitution amount owed by the Respondent from \$1,332,500 to \$1,206,250.
