

BOARD OF AUCTIONEERS MINUTES

1. The Board of Auctioneers convened at 9:00 a.m. with, Chairman Gregory J. Walsh, Vice-Chairman Roy W. Tilsley, Secretary Gregory J. Peverly, Member Russell R. Abbott and Member Robert P. Secord present.
2. The Board on motion of Russell R. Abbott, seconded by Robert P. Secord accepted the minutes of the April 4, 2016 meeting.
3. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by Gregory J. Peverly, authorized the application of Jason T. Little for an Auctioneers License.
4. The Board on motion of Gregory J. Peverly, seconded by Roy W. Tilsley, authorized the application of Lawrence J. Mahoney for an Auctioneers License.
5. The Board on motion of Roy W. Tilsley, seconded by Gregory J. Peverly, authorized the application of Thomas J. Noonan for an Auctioneers License.
6. Hearing in the Matter of Donald H. Champney – The Board on motion of Russell R. Abbott, seconded by Robert P. Secord, and with Roy W. Tilsley abstaining, found Mr. Champney in violation of RSA 311-B:11, II (d).
7. The Board on motion of Russell R. Abbott, seconded by Roy W. Tilsley, and further on a roll call vote as follows: Gregory J. Walsh – yes, Roy W. Tilsley – yes, Gregory J. Peverly – yes, Robert P. Secord – yes, and Russell R.
