REQUESTED ACTION

- 1) Authorize James M. Queenan Compliance Investigator of the New Hampshire Board of Pharmacy to attend the National Association of Board of Pharmacy Sterile Compounding Inspection Training to be held September 15 through and September 17, 2014 in Northbrook IL, effective upon Governor and Council approval.
- 2) Further authorize him, pursuant to RSA 4:8, and Administrative Rule 311.10, to accept complimentary scholarship including admission to the scheduled forum conference and travel, accommodations not to exceed \$ 1,500.

EXPLANATION

The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy, (NABP) is an impartial professional organization that supports the state boards of pharmacy in creating and enforcing uniform regulations to protect public health. NABP is hosting a two day training seminar for board investigators on sterile compounding. Experts in the field will train on inspection sterile techniques, acceptable primary and secondary engineering controls, quality assurance, technician training and documentation.


