### Requested Action

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police to accept the donation of a Wells Cargo Trailer with a value of approximately \$5,500.00 from the Defense Logistics Agency to be used by the Division of State Police Special Events Response Team (S.E.R.T). Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

### Explanation

The Department of Safety has been given the opportunity to acquire the above mentioned equipment through the 1033 Program property. The 1033 Program is the transfer of surplus military equipment from the Defense Logistics Agency (DLA) to Law Enforcement. Every state has a 1033 Program which was created to reutilize surplus military equipment that would otherwise be destroyed.


