#### EXPLANATION

The Department of Health and Human Services, Division for Behavioral Health, Bureau of Drug and Alcohol Services seeks approval to accept and expend MAT Grant federal funds in the amount of \$100,000 from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Service Administration (SAMHSA). This request represents the carryforward funds from year two of a multi-year grant (September 1, 2016 – August 31, 2019). This grant does not have a matching funds requirement.

The Medication Assisted Treatment grant (MAT) is being used to maintain the expansion of services in the high risk, high need communities of Nashua and Manchester. Contracts with federally qualified health centers provide MAT services in partnership with local specialty substance use disorder and recovery support providers giving patients access to care planning, coordination and delivery of care which is integrated and meets physical health, substance use disorder and co-occurring mental health service needs. The health centers continue to integrate efforts to outreach to diverse high risk populations, assess, diagnose and treatment plan, provide MAT services and access peer recovery coaches and other recovery support services.
