## REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 21-I:80, I(b), authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, Cannon Mountain to make a **SOLE SOURCE** and **RETROACTIVE** payment to New Hampshire Electric Motors, Inc. (VC #155097), Laconia, NH in the amount of \$1,250 for additional work done on the Aerial Tramway Motor DC Generator due to unforeseen issues in the original reconditioning scope of services. 100% Capital Fund

### **EXPLANATION**

New Hampshire Electric Motors (NHEM) was previously awarded a contract (September 3, 2014, Item #69) to recondition the 375kw 1780RPM DC generator at the Cannon Mountain Aerial Tramway. While working on and dissembling the generator, NHEM found more serious issues within the generator's bearing housing. Due to the availability of resources and convenience of NHEM having the motor on site, it was determined that to have NHEM complete the work would be the most cost effective and timely route. Rather than requesting to amend the existing contract which has expired, the Department is requesting sole source and retroactive approval to make payment to NHE Motor for this additional work.

#### REQUESTED ACTION

- Authorize the Department of Resources and Economic Development, Division of Parks and Recreation, Cannon Mountain to enter into a contract with New Hampshire Electric Motors, Inc. (VC #155097), Laconia, NH in the amount of \$6,600 to complete the Aerial Tramway Motor DC Generator reconditioning at Cannon Mountain Ski Area upon Governor and Executive Council approval through September 19, 2014. 100% Capital Funds
- 2. Further authorize a 5% contingency in the amount of \$330 to cover any unforeseen issues that may arise, which is not covered under the original scope of services, once the work is underway. 100% Capital Funds

## **EXPLANATION**

The generator drive system was installed during the original construction to power the main DC motor for the Cannon Aerial Tramway. Test results in 2012 revealed a significant degradation of the winding insulation and substantial winding continuity to ground. Due to these results it is imperative to recondition the 375kW 1780RPM DC generator and to have it in full working order in case of any unscheduled stops which could lead to disastrous consequences in transporting guests to and from the summit station.

On April 7, 2014 an invitation to submit bids for the "Aerial Tramway (Motor) DC Generator (Drive System) Reconditioning" was advertised on the Department of Administrative Services' website. NH Electric Motors was the lowest bid received; their skilled knowledge and understanding of the project also positions them as the best vendor to carry out the job. Attached for your information is a copy of the bid tabulation

The Attorney General's Office has reviewed and approved this contract as to form, substance and execution.
