REQUESTED ACTION


In accordance with RSA 94:3 the New Hampshire Liquor Commission requests to grant an annual salary increment to Joseph W. Mollica, Chairman, Position # 9U137, from Salary Grade HH, Step 4, \$95,219.18 to Salary Grade HH, Maximum \$100,170.95 effective upon Governor and Council approval.

Specifically on January 27, 2010 Governor and Council confirmed Joseph W. Mollica as the Commissioner and on July 2, 2011 Governor and Council confirmed Joseph W. Mollica as the Chairman until July 1, 2017, Salary Grade HH, Step 4. In accordance with RSA 94:8 Yearly Service Increases, Joseph W. Mollica is eligible for a salary increment, subject to the approval of Governor and Council.
