





With foreign acquisition of agricultural land, electrification, and the growing shortage of critical minerals dominating headlines, the topics and discussions at next week's Energy, Environment, and Agriculture Task Force meeting in Orlando are more pertinent than ever. In addition to the millions of jobs at risk from bad policy choices, the physical health and safety of Americans lay in the hands of our elected leaders as the country once again faces the specter of power loss during an increasingly hot summer.

Fortunately, the EEA Task Force has some of the brightest minds and policy experts in our field coming to Orlando to discuss these issues and more. We will be discussing how the impact on nonsensical chemical bans impact human health, ways to speed the process of bringing new power infrastructure online, and the delicate balance between maintaining the country's natural green spaces and updating the way we generate electricity.
