REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Justice to further amend Governor and Executive Council item #125, paragraph 2, approved on September 3, 2014, and amended on July 22, 2015, Item #122, by extending the subgrant end date to the NH Department of Safety from July 31, 2016 to a new end date of July 31, 2017 and by increasing the subgrant by \$56,992 from \$62,744 to \$119,736. 100% Federal Funds.

EXPLANATION

In a previous Governor and Council item, the New Hampshire Department of Justice was given approval to enter into a subgrant with the Department of Safety to help support staffing in the State Police Sex Offender Unit. These funds were awarded under the 2012 Byrne JAG Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) grant program administered through the Bureau of Justice Assistance, U.S. Department of Justice.


Through this request, we are seeking approval to extend the end date and to supplement the original award by increasing the subgrant by \$56,992 to the Department of Safety from the fourth supplement to the 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA.





REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Justice to retroactively amend Governor and Council item #12, approved on January 16, 2013, by extending the end date only of the sub grant to the NH Department of Safety (vendor #177878) in the amount of \$64,822 for sex offender unit staffing from the FFY 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA Grant Program from the original end date of September 30, 2013, to a new end date of September 30, 2014. This is 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account #02-20-20-201510-4458-072-500576, Job #20JAG12A, Department of Justice, entitled "Byrne JAG."

2. Authorize the Department of Justice to enter into a new sub grant with the NH Department of Safety (vendor #177878) in the amount of \$61,626 for sex offender unit staffing from the Supplemental FFY 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA Grant Program from the date of Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2014. This is 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in account #02-20-20-201510-4458-072-500576, Job #20JAG13A, Department of Justice, entitled "Byrne JAG."

EXPLANATION

This request is retroactive because our federal fiscal year 2012 funding was not able to be extended until the federal fiscal year 2013 award was made. Normally, New Hampshire could have requested an extension on our federal fiscal year 2012 funding well before it expired. In this case however, we could not make that request as the federal process for awarding these funds had changed between the federal fiscal year 2012 award and the fiscal year 2013 award.

The change to the process was to issue the federal fiscal year 2013 funding as a supplement to the federal fiscal year 2012 award rather than as a new separate fiscal year 2013 award. The federal awarding agency would not consider an extension on the 2012 end date because the 'pending' supplemental award would automatically extend the end date of federal fiscal year 2012 award when the federal fiscal year 2013 funding was added to it. As such, we had to wait for the new supplemental award document to be issued before we were able to make this sub grant extension request.

This request is to extend the current award from the federal fiscal year 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA and to make a new award of funding from the Supplemental 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA grant to the NH Department of Safety, Division of State Police, Sex Offender Unit.



EXPLANATION

Through this action, we are seeking approval to award funding from the federal fiscal year 2012 Byrne JAG SORNA grant to the NH Department of Safety, Division of State Police, Sex Offender Unit. These funds were awarded to the Department of Justice as a separate award from the federal fiscal year 2012 Byrne JAG grant. This award is to be used specifically in support of sex offender related activities and will be used to help support the NH State Police Sex Offender Unit.

In years past, these funds were included in the general Byrne JAG Grant to the Department of Justice, to be used for general law enforcement purposes. However, because the State's laws regarding sexual offender registration are not in substantial compliance with federal mandates under the Adam Walsh Act, 10% of the grant must now be used for sexual offender management.


