**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Alexandra C. Sosnowski to Position #9U552 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-26110000-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary level of \$78,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or May 6, 2022, whichever is later, for a term ending on December 14, 2024.

**EXPLANATION**


Ms. Sosnowski is a Concord resident and a member of the New Hampshire and Maine Bars. She graduated in 2013 from the University of New Hampshire, *cum laude*, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and Justice Studies. She earned her Juris Doctor in 2017 from the University of New Hampshire School of Law where she had been a Daniel Webster Scholar, Teaching Assistant, and Rudman Summer Fellow. While in law school, Ms. Sosnowski completed summer internships with the New Hampshire Department of Justice, Consumer Protection and Anti-Trust Bureau, and the University of New Hampshire, Institute for Health Policy and Practice. Following graduation she worked as Manager of Legal and Governmental Relations for Northeast Delta Dental where she was responsible for insurance and nonprofit regulatory compliance in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont. Ms. Sosnowski joined the Department in April 2021 and was assigned to the Consumer Protection and Anti-Trust Bureau. I plan to continue her current assignment. Her salary will increase by \$3,000 from \$75,000 to \$78,000. A copy of her resume is attached.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
